The proposal should include the title, name of the presenter(s), affiliation, mailing address, email address, and contact number(s). Presenters are asked to indicate the theme which their proposals address. Presenters must pay all registration and related conference fees. Letters of invitation will be provided for those who request them.

Conference Fee: \$495 (USD).

The official language of the World Congress is English.
